



## CIVHC/CHF Equity Fund Overview

### What is the CIVHC/CHF Equity Fund?

- The CIVHC/CHF Equity Fund was established as part of an agreement between CIVHC, the Center for Improving Value in Health Care (CIVHC) and the Colorado Health Foundation (CHF).
- Funds available via the CIVHC/CHF Equity Fund support community-based nonprofit organizations in Colorado focused on health equity by providing expanded access to CO APCD data, and research or evaluation services.
- We anticipate allocating \$250,000 per year, over four years up to \$1 million.
- The Equity Fund offsets CIVHC's costs associated with CO APCD data, research, and evaluation services and will subsidize up to \$50,000/project. This is not a direct grant program to a nonprofit organization.

### What organizations and projects are eligible for support?

- Eligible applicants are community-based nonprofit organizations in Colorado with less than \$10 million in annual operating revenue. Special consideration will be made for those organizations with larger annual operating revenue.
- Projects supported via the CIVHC/CHF Equity Fund must focus on health equity.
- Primary focus areas are housing access, food security, and maternal and fetal health.
- Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and will be awarded on a first come, first served basis.
- Applications are reviewed by the CIVHC/CHF Equity Fund Review Committee, which is comprised a multi-disciplinary team of data experts and community engagement leaders at CIVHC; the Senior Impact Officer from CHF; and representation from external community-based organizations.
