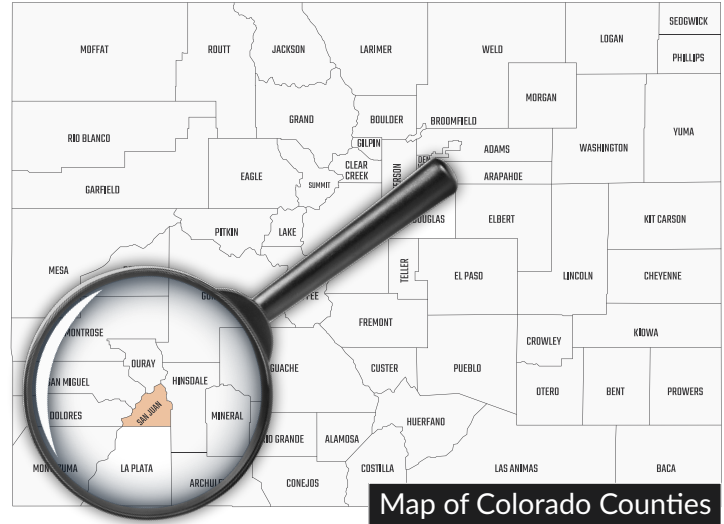

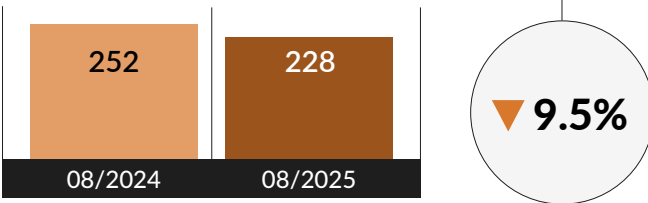

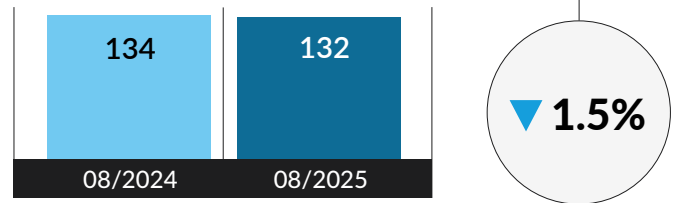
Year-Over-Year County Enrollment

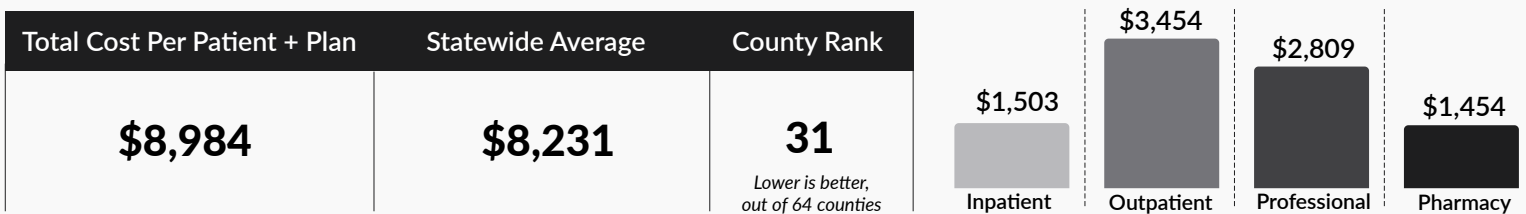

County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- San Juan County has a **consistently high rate of health care non-users**, or people who have insurance but do not use it. In 2023, the county's rate of non-users was 324 per 1,000 people compared to a statewide benchmark of 246 per 1,000 people and rural county benchmark of 243 per 1,000 people. San Juan is ranked second among all Colorado counties (ranked highest to lowest) in rate of non-users.
- San Juan County also has a **markedly lower rate of primary care users (per 1,000 people) compared to other Colorado counties**. In 2023, San Juan residents utilized primary care at a rate of 481 per 1,000, lower than the statewide benchmark of 547 per 1,000 people and rural county benchmark of 555 per 1,000 people.
- Children and adolescents in San Juan County **experience less access to dental care than in most other Colorado counties**. In 2023, the county recorded a 40% rate of children and adolescents accessing dental care, compared to a 53% benchmark in rural counties and statewide benchmark of 59%.
