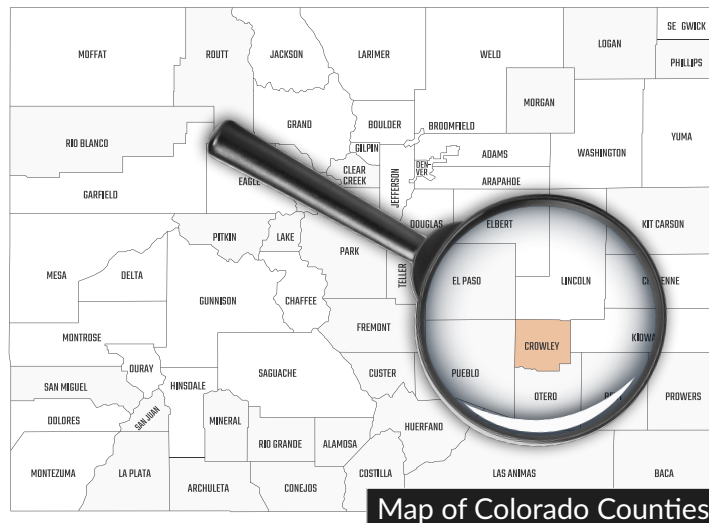

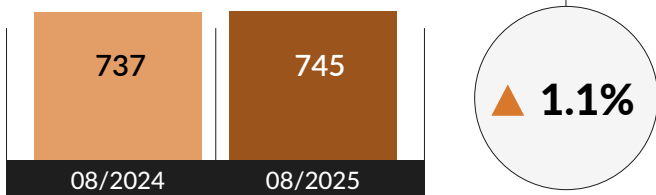

County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Fewer people in Crowley County **access primary care than in most Colorado counties**. In 2023, Crowley County recorded people accessing primary care at a rate of 443 per 1,000 people, notably below the statewide benchmark of 546 per 1,000 people and rural county benchmark of 555 per 1,000 people.
- Children and adolescents in Crowley County **access dental care at a higher rate than in other rural Colorado counties**. In 2023, children and adolescents in Crowley County accessed dental care at a rate of 58%, just below the statewide benchmark of 59% and above the rural county benchmark of 53%.
- People who are eligible in Crowley County **receive breast cancer screenings at a lower rate than most other counties**. In 2023, eligible people in Crowley County received breast cancer screenings at a rate of 53%, below the statewide benchmark of 63% and benchmark for other rural counties of 61%.
