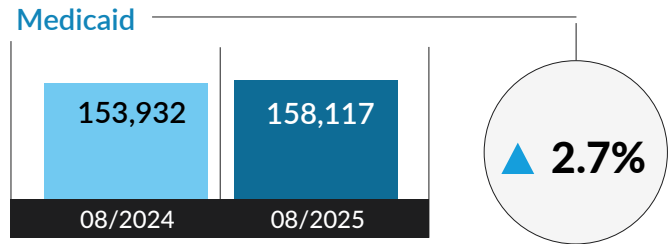
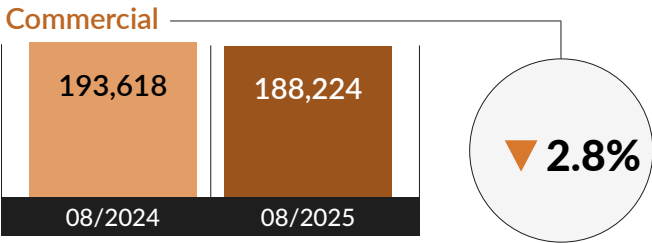

## Year-Over-Year County Enrollment

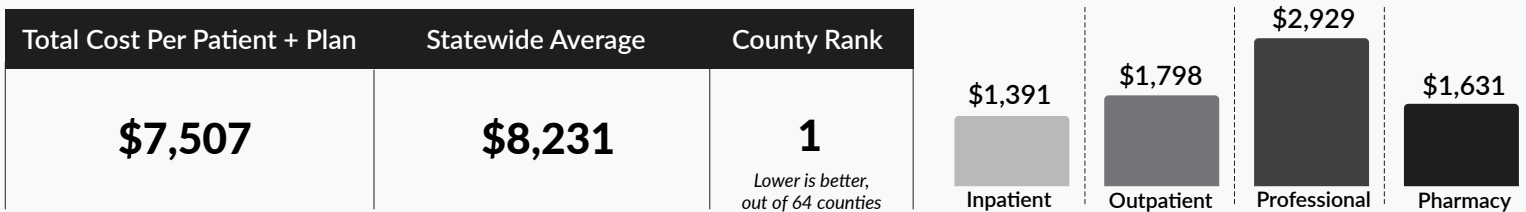

## County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- El Paso County has the **lowest total spending on care (health plan and patient, PPPY) of any county in Colorado**. In 2023, El Paso County recorded total spending amount of \$7,507 PPPY compared to a statewide benchmark of \$8,231 PPPY.
- El Paso County records a **higher rate of health care non-users**, or people with insurance coverage who do not use it, compared to other urban counties and Colorado counties overall. In 2023, El Paso County recorded non-users at a rate of 278 per 1,000 people, higher than the statewide benchmark of 246 per 1,000 and urban county benchmark of 247 per 1,000.
- El Paso County also has a **lower rate of primary care visits** than many Colorado counties. In 2023, the county recorded 514 primary care visits per 1,000 people, below the statewide average of 547 visits per 1,000 people and urban county benchmark of 546 visits per 1,000 people.
