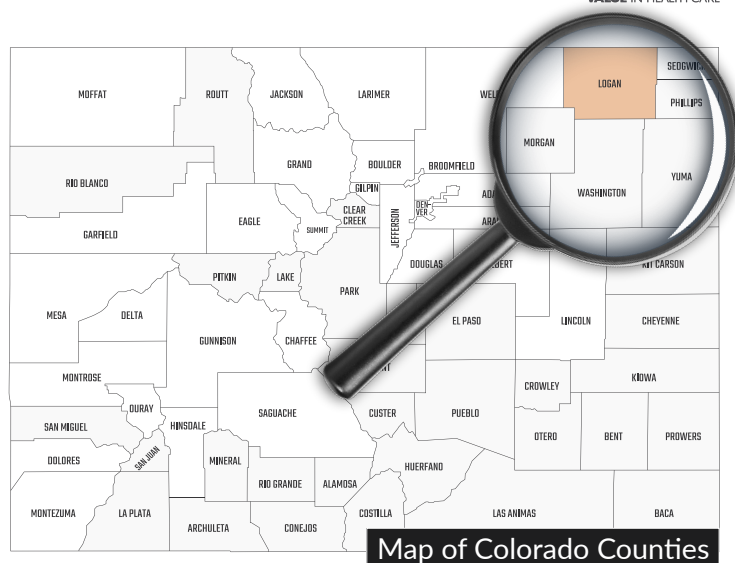

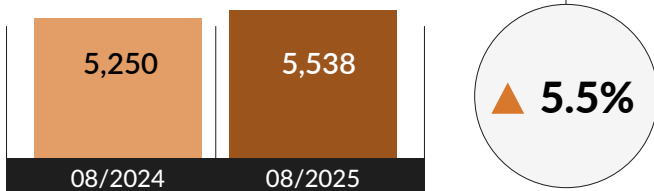

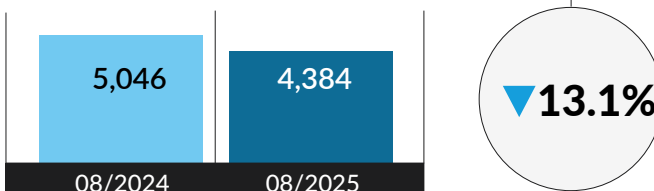
Year-Over-Year County Enrollment

County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Logan County has a **lower rate of health care non-users**, or people with insurance coverage who do not use it, compared to other rural counties and Colorado counties overall. In 2023, Logan County's rate of non-users was 208 per 1,000 people, above the statewide benchmark of 246 per 1,000 people and rural county benchmark of 243 per 1,000 people.
- People in Logan County **visit the emergency department (ED) at the highest rate** of any Colorado county. In 2023, people in Logan County visited the ED at a rate of 561 per 1,000 people, far above the statewide benchmark of 316 per 1,000.
- Children and adolescents in Logan County **receive access to dental care at a lower rate than most Colorado counties**. In 2023, the county recorded children and adolescents accessing care at a rate of 48%, below the statewide benchmark of 59% and rural county benchmark of 53%.
