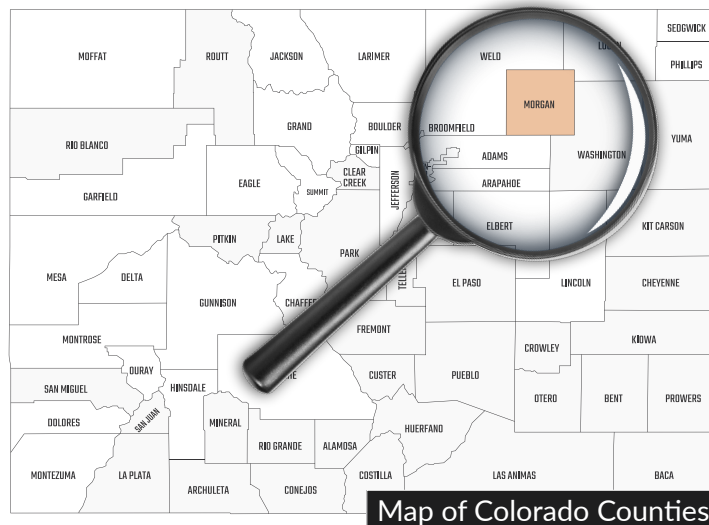

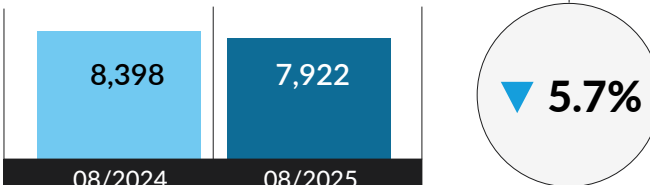
Year-Over-Year County Enrollment

County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Morgan County has a **lower rate of primary care visits** than most Colorado counties. In 2023, Morgan County recorded 474 primary care visits per 1,000 people, below the statewide benchmark of 547 visits per 1,000 people and the rural county benchmark of 555 visits per 1,000 people.
- Morgan County has a **lower rate of eligible people who receive their breast cancer screenings** compared to other Colorado counties. In 2023, Morgan County recorded a rate of eligible people accessing breast cancer screenings of 54%, below the statewide benchmark of 63% and rural county benchmark of 61%.
- People living in Morgan County **visit the emergency department (ED) at a higher rate than most counties** in Colorado. In 2023, Morgan County recorded ED visits at a rate of 507 per 1,000 people compared to a statewide benchmark of 316 per 1,000 people. Overall, Morgan County ranks fourth highest among Colorado counties ranked by ED visit rate.
