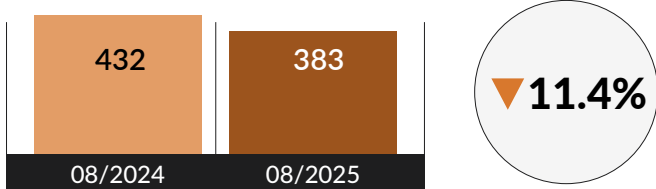

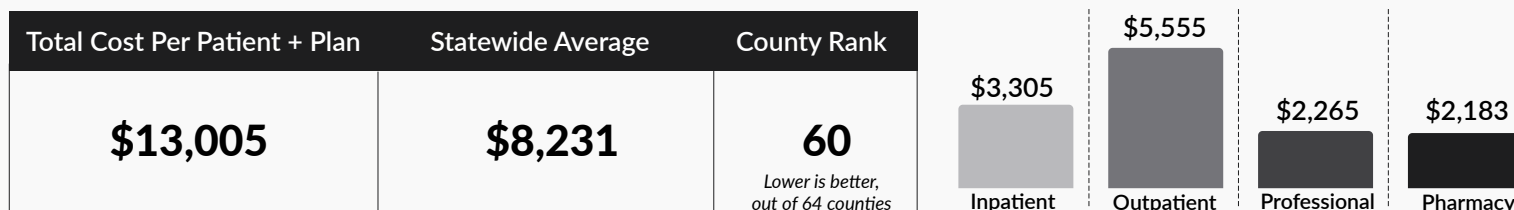

County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Sedgwick County has one of the **highest rates of spending on care among all Colorado counties**. In 2023, the total cost of care (plan + patient) was \$13,005, compared to the rural benchmark of \$9,534 and statewide benchmark of \$8,231. Among all Colorado counties, Sedgwick ranks 60 out of 64 counties (ranked lowest to highest) in spending on care.
- Sedgwick County has a **higher rate of people who access primary care** than most Colorado counties. In 2023, Sedgwick County recorded primary care users accessing care at a rate of 644 per 1,000 people, compared to the statewide benchmark of 547 per 1,000 people and rural county benchmark of 555 per 1,000.
- Sedgwick County is tied with Hinsdale County for having the **lowest rate of children and adolescents accessing dental care** in Colorado. In 2023, Sedgwick County recorded children and adolescents accessing dental care at a rate of 32%, far below the statewide benchmark of 59% and rural county benchmark of 53%.
