Committee Discussion and Questions:

- Beth: not entirely clear from the application. Are you requesting all claims associated with people with one of the Dx codes, or exclusively claims for the code list?
 - Dr. Velopulos: Ideally, we would see all claims to get more insight to temporal relationships and where things are related that might not appear to be related on a first pass
- Essey: Social Determinants of Health (SDoH) impacting access to care—still curious about insurance types to see how that impacts access. Will you be stratifying that data by different insurance types, maybe to see high-deductible plans? Will you be comparing the Social Vulnerability Index (SVI) plus insurance type, or SVI plus race or ethnicity or zip code?
 - Dr. Velopulos: Absolutely. The insurance status is a big issue. Colorado has more insured individuals, but there are other resources factoring in such as time off work and childcare. A lot of the work to look at disparities is hoping to evaluate access to specialty care. Hoping to look at all the involved



factors that create caveats to access. Most of the work done in this field looks at an incomplete snapshot not capturing SVI. Some other indexes, such as ADI, are only capturing the zip-code level. SVI equips more robust code and group analysis through the four layers at the local and state levels

- PI team drops from call, Kelsey asks for any further questions from the committee
- Jesse and Chris express that this project brings a lot of value and is being led by a great team
- Beth would prefer to see the finalized IRB before work starting, but would not let that be an objection
 - Lucía: a secondary IRB has been submitted, some certificates were requested as a follow-up and have been submitted for final IRB approval
 - Compliance and CIVHC agree that all IRB approvals are expected to be in place before production
