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Committee Discussion and Questions

- Kimi shares brief overview of project and funding mechanism (Robert Wood Johnson)
- Chris Behrer joins the call and shares their materials
- Nathan: will you be adjusting regional variations?
 - Chris: Yes
- Nathan: the published pricing is listed pricing (i.e. walk in the door with cash) but most payments come from third-party insurers. Curious if the impact of that is less about list price and more about what can be negotiated with the insurance providers
 - Chris: the transparency legislation requires insurers to post the negotiated prices, so they are observable. Market power is very important and a key reason a claims data set will be important instead of just pricing observations. Providers have more leverage if they see more patients, so it would be very valuable to see the prices between practices and the corresponding volume changes between those practices
- Nathan: when a practice is taken over, it's not just the pricing changes but what else they are doing to change the pricing structure overall. Maybe the original doctor was only doing minimum needs, but the new doctor is pushing for additional testing. Are you looking at that?
 - Chris: total billing, total spending per capita. The proposal should be something that needs to be done within the set amount of time, so the pricing piece is the main focus for this study but there is a lot of interest in the totals. If that can be completed within the grant timeline, that would be fantastic
- Jesse: when price adjustments occur based on contract renegotiations, inflationary effects are important to consider. There are markedly higher goals this renewal period given higher rates over the past two years
 - Chris: healthcare inflation is a great point and something to keep an eye on
