- PI joins the call and presents project details
- Nathan: the pool of participants has a set number. ASD has significantly higher prevalence than CP, so will the pools match up? Is this the ideal comparison group? We have done control group matching in the past to look for demographics
 - Cristina Sarmiento: talking with some of the other team members who have worked with CO APCD data before agreed that finding an exact match to the CP group would be difficult. The overlap in the two groups compared to other developmental disabilities is significantly lower, which should give more unique members within groups
- Ako: would it be easy to exclude folks via a population without any issues, and then see their preventative visits as a baseline?
 - CS: that takeaway would certainly be an easy story to understand, and might be worth revisiting with the rest of the internal team who are more familiar with CO APCD data

- Amanda provides brief overview of request for Committee
- Committee member Andy Woster is leading this request; presents project details
 - No questions from the Committee on the request
- PI team (including Andy) drops from call and Kelsey asks for further questions from Committee
- Ako: framing this is as a large refresh request, correct?
 - Amanda: the census data is the new PHI element, and the use cases have been adjusted a bit, but otherwise this is essentially a refresh
- Jesse: CCMCN could potentially use EHR data for the census tract elements, if needed
- Nathan: curious about the data vault and their use of data by proxy through the system. How do we account for that use? We hold requesters responsible for DUAs and data protection, but what about these cases where someone else is permitted to pull the data?
 - Kelsey: DUA reviews and revisions were made to find a custom framework for this work with CCMCN. Project Workforce was specifically accounted for in the DUA for this model, and will be utilizing a quarterly review period to account for workforce size
 - Ako: are there accounts for resell provisions in the DUA?
 - Kelsey: the DUAs have re-use provisions, with approvals required per use case. The DUA has multiple provisions for no use case beyond the original use case. Data from the CO APCD is licensed, not sold, so there is not a provision in the DUA for 're-sell' specifically because there is no sale in the first place. Any requestor is also required to send CIVHC all pre-publication materials

- There is no external presenter for this request. Amanda provides full overview of request
 - Paul McCormick is available to answer technical questions about the grouper
- Nathan: KPMG will take the data, run grouping, and then send the data set back. Are we already doing episode grouping?
 - Amanda: CIVHC has done grouping in the past using a different program and different partner organization. We have not had a grouper since that work closed in 2022
 - Nathan: what were we doing for bundled payment reports?
 - Pete: we were providing data back to HCPF for one or two of their projects. We had a set of bundled payment costs as part of the Shop for Care tool. We have some other potential projects hoping to make use of the grouper and bundled payment reports
 - Nathan: is this a commercial product?
 - Paul: it is a commercial product, there is a collaborative bringing to together experts from the medical claims side. It's been in use for years in other states
 - Ako: assuming it contains DRGs?
 - Paul: it is not limited to DRGs, but does utilize them
