

# Shop for Care Methodology

Spring 2024

# Background

As administrator of the Colorado All Payer Claims Database (CO APCD), the Center for Improving Value in Health Care (CIVHC) is required to make public price information available to consumers. The Shop for Care tool is available at <u>www.civhc.org</u> and enables consumers, providers and others to compare prices for select services and quality information on a named facility basis. The tool is updated regularly as new years of data become available in the CO APCD. This document supplements the online Frequently Asked Questions resource on the Shop for Care page and outlines more detailed methodology regarding the analytics behind the output in the tool.

# **Key Considerations**

- Only commercial data is used in this report. The commercial data in the CO APCD includes the majority of fully insured and small group covered lives in Colorado, and approximately 50% of self-insured covered lives (see CO APCD Insights Dashboard at www.civhc.org for more information).
- The data only includes payments for in-network providers.
- Payments represent total allowed amounts (plan and patient paid) for the facility portion of the claim only. Payments do not include professional (provider) fees or other ancillary fees that may be billed in addition to the facility fee for the service.

# The procedures in the tool are broken down into the following categories. Please see Appendix A for a full list of procedures:

- Cardiology
- Laboratory Services
- Physical and Occupational Therapy

- Mental and Behavioral Health Services
- Radiology and Imaging
- Obstetric/Gynecological Services
- Surgical, Diagnostic & Infusion Procedures

# **Selection Criteria**

CIVHC included claims and services with the following characteristics:

- Commercial only
- Payments provided by primary health insurance payers only
- Allowed amount greater than \$1
- Procedures and services with eleven or more claims for at least five facilities
  - Both Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes and Medicare Severity Diagnosis Related Groups (MS-DRGs) codes were used to identify procedures and services
- Only the facility payments are included in the prices displayed in the tool (no professional fees or additional services that may have occurred on the same day or visit are included in the price estimates)
  - Professional claims with a modifier of "TC", which indicates that the cost corresponds to performing the test only, not the interpretation, were included
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Claims billed by selected Colorado hospital, ambulatory surgery centers and imaging centers were included

Extremely low or high payments **were** *not* **excluded** from the analysis since those types of payments are eliminated from the data displayed with the use of 25<sup>th</sup>-75<sup>th</sup> percentile range.

# Definitions

#### Payments

The analysis provides payment information in the form of total allowed amounts which are the combined sum of the amount of dollars paid by the health insurance plan and patient (which includes copay, coinsurance and deductibles). This analysis includes 25<sup>th</sup> and 75th percentile allowed amounts (displayed as "Price Range"), as well as median amounts (displayed as "Average Price"). In the interactive report, allowed amounts are described as "prices".

• Flat Fee vs. Per Unit Prices: The tool also displays the way the service or code gets paid. Flat fee codes are payed for using a fixed rate payment while per unit code payments will vary and show the cost of a single unit of the service rendered (units can be time unit, drug dosage unit, etc.).

Average Prices are calculated based on the median payment (both the payer and patient portion combined) made to that particular provider for the **facility-only part of the bill** (no provider or other fees included) across all commercial payers in the CO APCD.

**Price Range** is calculated using the 25<sup>th</sup> to 75<sup>th</sup> percentile range of payments made by both the payer and the patient by all commercial payers. Providing the price range helps users understand the "typical" low and high end of payments for each facility while eliminating outliers on both ends. In some instances, the price range is the same as the "average price" listed, which could indicate that the facility negotiates only one standard price regardless of the payer, or they may only have one payer represented in the CO APCD for commercial claims.

**Note:** All Prices are rounded up to the nearest \$10 and, as such, some prices may reflect \$0 when the price is less than \$5.

#### **Quality Measures**

The patient experience rating comes from a survey called the <u>Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare</u> <u>Providers and Systems</u>, or HCAHPS. The survey is given to adult patients between 48 hours and six weeks after leaving the hospital.

The overall hospital quality rating comes from data hospitals report to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for the Hospital Inpatient and Outpatient Quality Reporting programs. The data is summarized into a single star rating for each hospital. You can visit the CMS <u>website</u> for more information about the star ratings.

It is important to note the quality measures on the Shop for Care tool are high-level ratings that are not related to a specific procedure. Some procedure-specific quality information is available on the CMS website, but it is limited to specific services and does not include all options on the Shop for Care tool.

Quality measures are not available for imaging and ambulatory surgery centers, or for hospitals not required to report to CMS due to low volume of Medicare claims.

#### **Assigning Outpatient Facilities to Affiliated Hospital Campuses**

In many instances, a hospital or hospital system owns or operates an offsite outpatient clinic or facility. In order to attribute outpatient claims billed under a separate identifier to a hospital for outpatient prices, CIVHC went through the following process:

1. Identified all facilities in the CO APCD classified as 'General Acute Care Hospital' using NPPES classification system.

- 2. Matched all facilities with the same organization name as identified in Step 1.
- 3. Rolled up remaining facilities into one of the hospitals identified in Step 1 using the steps below:
  - Group facilities by ORGANIZATION NAME and ZIP CODE.
    - Facility IDs having the same organization name and zip code as a facility with a hospital taxonomy identified in Step 1 were grouped together.
  - Group facilities by ORGANIZATION NAME and COUNTY.
    - Facility IDs that did not match on zip code, but were in the same county and had the same organization name as a facility with a hospital taxonomy were subsequently grouped together.
    - Some counties had multiple hospitals within the same system (e.g. El Paso, Denver) and a manual review was necessary.
  - The remaining facilities that did not match on zip code or county were grouped by the following:
    - The main general acute hospital that was (a) in the same hospital network and (b) located within the closest distance (miles).

#### Resources Used:

- The Colorado Hospital Association's directory <u>list</u> was used to cross-reference the following:
  - Facility name
  - Address
  - Hospitals that did not have an NPPES General Acute Hospital classification
  - Critical Access Hospital status
- Google Maps and the Colorado Department of Public Health facility lists were used to further confirm addresses from Colorado Hospital Association's list.

#### **Facility Assignment**

**Ambulatory Surgery Centers:** Free standing surgical centers were identified in the CO APCD through the CMS National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES):

- Grouping: Ambulatory Health Care Facilities
- Classification: Clinic/Center
- Specialization: Ambulatory Surgical

#### **Preview and Validation Process**

The Shop for Care tool is released in a soft launch 15 days prior to publishing publicly. Facilities receive an email and access to a spreadsheet with their data and the data for their peers. They have 15 days to review and raise any questions about the prices for each of their attributed procedures. When facilities have questions about the price displayed, CIVHC may provide them with information for each single procedure depending on the extent of their questions. In some instances, after discussing the results with facilities, CIVHC has elected to exclude some procedures for a provider for various reasons including that they were paid a bundled amount for those specific procedures and it was not providing an apples-to-apples comparison with

their peers who were paid through fee-for-service, or that a facility that was displaying in the tool was no longer open.

### **Additional Information**

#### **Data Suppression**

Data Suppression following privacy protection standards used by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), data are suppressed for facilities that had fewer than 11 claims for a single provider.

**Note:** In some instances, a facility may perform a higher volume of services than are captured in the CO APCD commercial claims submissions for a particular year. If you do not see a facility you think offers a service you are looking for, please contact them directly for pricing or contact <u>info@civhc.org</u> to inquire.

#### **Service Dates Included**

The service year is defined by the service start date on each claim. This analysis includes claims data for service dates from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

#### Data Vintage

This report is based off claims data in the CO APCD data warehouse refresh on **March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024**.
