CO APCD Products

CO APCD provides a number of data products, available in different formats with various levels of customization to meet a variety of needs.

Data Sets CO APCD data is provided as a set of pipe-delimited text files without analytics.

Custom Data Sets

Three file options are available to fit your specific use case and requirements. These data sets are customizable, they can also include APR-DRGs or geocoding elements such as census tract and census block information. You will work with CIVHC to select the elements for your data set as well as determine the level of protected health information (PHI) necessary to complete your project.

- De-Identifiable Data Set no Protected Health Information (PHI).
- Limited Data Set a limited set of PHI data elements (such as Zip Code or Date of Service).
- Fully-Identifiable Data Set can incorporate select PHI elements based on your use case, subject to the minimum and necessary level of data needed to complete the project, as well as meeting HIPAA regulatory guidelines.

Data Set	User	Example Use Cases
De-Identified	Government Agency	Assess state spending and utilization for services for children to optimize state investments and federal matching potential.
De-Identified	Provider	Reimbursement & utilization trends for a wide range of clinical services.
Limited	Community-Focused Organization	Analyze the impact of supportive housing on access to health care and health care outcomes.
Limited	Researcher	Examine the correlation between type of insurance and healthcare utilization and spending patterns, including patient's out-of-pocket costs.
Fully-Identified	Government Agency	Study how health plan eligibility impacts health care utilization, cost, and outcomes.
Fully-Identified	Researcher	Investigate disparities in waitlist, survival rates, and health outcomes for organ transplant and organ failure patients.

Standard De-Identified Data Sets

Four standard data sets are available with different combinations of de-identified data elements and can typically be delivered within 30 calendar days following signing of data licensing documents. In addition to the specific elements below, all Standard Data Sets feature:

- The most current three years of data from commercial payers (including Medicare Advantage).
- Ability to be expanded to incorporate additional years as well as Medicaid data.
- Medicare Severity Diagnosis Related Groups (MS DRGs).
- Member event sequencing to allow users to see the timeline of care.

Researcher	A retrospective cohort study to measure the utilization and total cost of care for patients accessing cancer treatment, for 17 cancer types (Pan-tumor and by cancer type).
Researcher	Educate and train the next generation of data scientists and health care leaders in Colorado and across the nation on how to use claims data in their research projects.











Reports | Aggregated de-identified reports with analytics provided by CIVHC.

Custom Reports

Custom reports include customizable data elements and analytics. Government Agency	Assess the impact of individual and household characteristics on the utilization of telehealth and in-person services.
Researcher	Investigate the incidence of cancer near a former nuclear weapons production facility compared to the rest of Colorado during the same time period.

Reports on specific topics with narrow customization options that do not require you to perform any additional analysis.

Employer	Examine where local residents are getting health care and opportunities to design strategies to address costs with local businesses and providers.
