
The COVID-19 pandemic accelerated the adoption of telehealth services, reshaping health care delivery in Colorado. Using claims data from the CO APCD, the Telehealth Services Analysis provides critical insights into this transformation. The data highlights how Coloradans have accessed telehealth pre and post pandemic, shedding light on trends in services, provider utilization, and geographic and demographic differences.

Utilization Trends


Telehealth visits with behavioral health providers have remained high while visits with primary care providers have dropped more significantly.




Top Diagnoses

% of Telehealth Services with Mental Health Diagnosis







Rural vs. Urban | 2023












Medicaid insured patients used telehealth services the most




Demographics | 2023
