


Year-Over-Year County Enrollment



County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Broomfield County has a **higher rate of primary care visits than state benchmark**. In 2023, 627 per 1,000 people in Broomfield had a primary care visit, above both statewide and urban county benchmarks at 547 and 546 people per 1,000.
- Broomfield County has a **higher breast cancer screening rates** than most Colorado counties, ranking in the top 10 counties for screening rates in 2023 at 68%.
- Broomfield County has a **lower rate of emergency department (ED) visits than most Colorado counties**, ranking in the top third of counties ranked (lowest to highest) for ED visits (236 per 1,000) and potentially preventable (85 per 1,000) ED visits, demonstrating lower rates of visits overall in 2023.
