




Year-Over-Year County Enrollment



County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Elbert County has **higher professional service health plan & patient spending compared to most counties**. In 2023, the average spending was \$3,347 per person, compared to the statewide benchmark of \$2,876. Elbert ranked 5th among 64 counties (ranked highest to lowest).
- Elbert County has a **higher rate of primary care use than most counties**. In 2023, the county saw 610 visits per 1,000 people, ranking in the top 12 counties for primary care use (ranked highest to lowest).
- Elbert County has one of the **lowest rates of emergency department (ED) and potentially preventable ED visits**. In 2023, the county saw 206 ED visits per 1,000 people (ranked 11th lowest) and 71 preventable visits per 1,000 people (ranked 9th lowest).
