

County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Jefferson County has a **lower overall spending on care compared to most Colorado counties**. In 2023, the county ranked 9th (ranked lowest to highest) for total cost of care (plan + patient), landing in the top 10 alongside other Denver Metro counties including Adams, Broomfield, and Denver.
- Jefferson County has a **relatively low rate of potentially preventable emergency department visits**. In 2023, the county recorded 87 visits per 1,000 people, compared to the statewide benchmark of 119.
- Jefferson County has **slightly above-average primary care use**. In 2023, the county recorded 595 visits per 1,000 people, compared to the statewide benchmark of 547. Overall, the county aligns closely with statewide and urban trends for utilization.
