


## Year-Over-Year County Enrollment



## County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Jackson County has lower spending on care compared to most Colorado counties. In 2023, combined health plan and patient spending was \$7,975 per person per year. This places Jackson 10th lowest in the state (ranked lowest to highest), below the statewide benchmark of \$8,231.
- Jackson County has one of the lowest rates of healthy users, or people using coverage mainly for routine care (such as preventive screenings), among Colorado counties. In 2023, the county recorded 96 visits per 1,000 people compared to the state benchmark of 148 people. This places Jackson second among counties ranked by healthy users (lowest to highest).
- In 2023, Jackson County experienced fewer potentially preventable emergency department (ED) visits than recorded in any year since the beginning of Community Dashboard tracking in 2013. In 2022, the county recorded 103 visits per 1,000 people. That fell to 48 visits per 1,000 people in 2023.
