



County Trends and Notes | All measures reflect data from the [Community Dashboard](#) (2013 -2023)

- Larimer County has **one of the lowest total costs of care in Colorado**. In 2023, total cost of care (plan + patient) was \$7,723 per person per year, placing Larimer 3rd lowest among all counties (ranked lowest to highest) and well below the statewide benchmark of \$8,231.
- Larimer County has consistently high rates of primary care use. Since 2014, recorded rates of primary care use in Larimer County have been above statewide and urban county benchmarks. In 2023, the county recorded 588 visits per 1,000 people, above the statewide benchmark of 547. Larimer ranked in the top 20 counties for primary care utilization (ranked highest to lowest).
- Larimer County has a slightly lower rate of plan non-users than statewide and urban benchmarks. However, the county has experienced a sharp increase in non-users in recent years. From 2020 to 2023, the rate rose from 171 to 225 per 1,000 people, mirroring statewide increase trends.
